- Batting Cage-Trevor update (committee needed)
  - A dry building will cost over \$50,000
  - Netted cage w/small building for machines (open door and go) would be about \$20,000
  - Thelma motioned to move the batting cages to a committee and Joe seconded the motion; motion passed
    - Committee members are Trevor, Tim, and Colin
    - Report back in February
- District update:
  - Need to order new LL patches; these are now non divisional for both softball and baseball (old ones are okay, just order new when you run out)
  - Order rulebooks asap as they sell out quickly.
  - Interleague rules to be discussed next meeting (Trevor to represent NCLL) however Juniors and down have a continuous lineup moving forward including tournaments. Leadoff rule now enforced as an out needs to be researched.
  - Need venues and hosts for 2023 tournament, if no volunteers by end of March, 1st tournament is canceled.
  - League assessments will be increased from \$10/team as that amount didn't cover costs last year.
  - Potential Super League for softball this year where we would combine boundaries. This is based on total sign-ups.
  - No dates for umpire meetings but they will be happening soon.
